

### Agency Efforts to Prepare Children for School

The four year old children served in the Families First of Minnesota Head Start in 24-25 began the year at an average of 64% falling within the widely held expectations for their age across the developmental domains of social/emotional, physical, cognitive and language. In the spring, the children demonstrated progress that was on average of 85% within the widely held expectations for their age.
